The Legacy of a Gifted Teacher Remembering Jo Ann Wexler

Think for a moment about a teacher who impacted your life.

Perhaps you were going through a difficult time and that teacher provided a safe place to speak, and somehow imparted the strength to face the challenges of the moment. Or maybe it was the teacher who saw some special ability or quality in you that others missed. Then there are those whose enthusiasm for the subject matter, mixed with a genius for teaching, made a book or an idea come alive in a way that moved you to the core. Some have had the privilege of studying with teachers who literally changed the trajectory of their lives. For many students who have attended the Bernard Zell Anshe Emet Day School, the name Jo Ann Wexler, better known as Ms. Wex, will come to mind. Jo Ann was a master teacher and a remarkable person who sadly succumbed to a difficult illness.

Jo Ann was a teacher at the school for more than 40 years. While she was an excellent pedagogue, it was the manner in which Jo Ann cared for each student, the love she exuded, that truly defined her. She saw the Bernard Zell Anshe Emet Day School as an extension of her own family, which says a great deal. Ms. Wex would often speak quite lovingly of her family members, most especially her niece and nephew. Parents could immediately sense how important your child was to her, and that it was a privilege for your child to have her as teacher. What always impressed me was how she maintained that same keen interest years after children left her classroom and graduated from the school.

In our tradition, the words of Torah, teacher and parents are interconnected. That is to say a true teacher is the one who

elevates their subject matter to the level of Torah, whose teaching methodology engages everyone in the classroom and brings the love and concern of a parent to each student. Jo Ann Wexler truly embodied this teaching. As a result, Ms. Wex will long be remembered as one of those extraordinary teachers who impacted generations of lives and helped to define the best of the Bernard Zell Anshe Emet Day School.

May Jo Ann's memory forever be a blessing.



Dr. Goodman also directs Beit Midrash Yisraeli - Ein Prat, Israel's leading pluralistic Beit Midrash for young adults






Mazel Tov to Our Own Samantha Isenstein!


