After we take the Torah out of the Ark, you hold it and face the congregation and sing:

שְׁמַע יִשְּׂרָאֵל, יְיָ אֱלֹהֵינוּ, יְיָ אֶּחְד.

Wait until the congregation repeats it

Then you sing: אֶּרֶר אֱלֹהֵינוּ, נְּרוֹל אֲרוֹנֵנוּ, כְרוֹשׁ שְׁמוֹ. Wait, again, until the congregation repeats it.

Then you turn around and face the ark.

Once we all finish turning to face the ark, give a little bow and sing:

Nobody repeats this line.

You then walk with the Torah toward the rabbi's side of the bimah and down the stairs and circulate the sanctuary, letting everyone who wants to kiss the Torah. The Hazzan and everyone will be singing this while you parade the Torah around and bring it back up to the bimah:

לְדְ יְיָ הַגְּּדְלָּה וְהַגְּבוּרָה וְהַתִּפְּאֶרֶת וְהַגִּצְח וְהַהוֹד, כִּי כֹל בַּשָּׁמֵים וּבָאֶרֶץ, לְדְ יִיָ הַמַּמְלְכָה, וְהַמִּתְנַשֵּׁא לְכֹל לְרֹאשׁ. רוֹמְמוּ יִיְ אֱלֹהֵינוּ, וְהִשְּׁתַחֲווּ לַהֲדֹם רַגְּלָיוּ, קְדוֹשׁ הוּא. רוֹמְמוּ יְיָ אֶלֹהֵינוּ, וְהִשְּׁתַחֲווּ לְהַר קִּדְשׁוֹ, כִּי קְדוֹשׁ יְיָ אֱלֹהֵינוּ.
