

Shavuot: Day 2 (Shabbat)

[Deuteronomy]

(14)22: You shall surely tithe all the increase of your seed, that which comes forth from the field year by year.

23: You shall eat before the LORD your God, in the place which He shall choose to cause His name to dwell there, the tithe of your grain, of your wine, and of your oil,

and the firstborn of your herd and of your flock; that you may learn to fear the LORD your God always.

24: If the way be too long for you,

so that you are not able to carry it, because the place is too far from you, which the LORD your God shall choose, to set His name there, for the LORD your God shall bless you;

25: then shall you turn it into money, and bind up the money in your hand,

and shall go to the place which the LORD your God shall choose:

26: and you shall exchange the money for whatever your soul desires, for oxen, or for sheep,

or for wine, or for strong drink, or for whatever your soul asks of you;

and you shall eat there before the LORD your God, and you shall rejoice, you and your household.

27: The Levite who is within your gates, you shall not forsake him; for he has no portion nor inheritance with you.

28: At the end of every three years

you shall bring forth all the tithe of your increase in the same year,

and shall lay it up within your gates: 29: and the Levite shall come, because he has no portion nor inheritance with you, and the sojourner, and the fatherless, and the widow, who are within your gates, and shall eat and be satisfied; that the LORD your God may bless you in all the work of your hand which you do.

(15)1: At the end of every seven years you shall make a release.

that which he has lent to his neighbor; he shall not exact it of his neighbor and his brother;

because the LORD's release has been proclaimed.

3: Of a foreigner you may exact it:

but whatever of yours is with your brother your hand shall release. 4: However there shall be no poor with you, for the LORD will surely bless you in the land which the LORD your God

gives you for an inheritance to possess it; 5: if only you diligently listen

to the voice of the LORD your God, to observe to do all these commandments

which I command you this day. 6: For the LORD your God will bless you,

as He promised you: and you shall lend to many nations,

but you shall not borrow; and you shall rule over many nations,

but they shall not rule over you. 7: If there be with you a poor man,

one of your brothers, within any of your gates in your land which the LORD your God gives you,

you shall not harden your heart,

nor shut your hand from your poor brother; 8: but you shall surely open your hand to him,

and shall surely lend him sufficient for his need in that which he wants.

9: Beware that there not be a base thought in your heart, saying,

The seventh year, the year of release, is at hand;

and your eye begrudge your poor brother, and you give him nothing;

and he cry to the LORD against you, and it be a sin to you. 10: You shall surely give him,

and your heart shall not be grieved when you give to him; because for this thing

the LORD your God will bless you in all your work, and in all that you put your hand to.
