

# Ki Tavo: Weekday

[Deuteronomy]

(26)1: It shall be, when you are come in to the land which the LORD your God gives you for an inheritance, and possess it, and dwell therein, 2: that you shall take of the first of all the fruit of the ground,

which you shall bring in from your land that the LORD your God gives you;

and you shall put it in a basket, and shall go to the place

which the LORD your God shall choose, to cause His name to dwell there.

3: You shall come to the priest who shall be in those days,

and tell him, I profess this day to the LORD your God, that I am come to the land

which the LORD swore to our fathers to give us.

4: The priest shall take the basket out of your hand, and set it down before the altar of the LORD your God.

5: You shall speak up and say before the LORD your God, A wandering Aramean was my father;

and he went down into Egypt, and sojourned there, few in number; and he became there a nation, great, mighty, and populous.

6: The Egyptians dealt ill with us, and afflicted us,

and laid on us hard bondage: 7: and we cried to the LORD, the God of our fathers,

and the LORD heard our voice, and saw our affliction, and our toil, and our oppression;

8: and the LORD brought us forth out of Egypt with a mighty hand, and with an outstretched arm,

and with great terror, and with signs, and with wonders; 9: and He brought us into this place,

and gave us this land, a land flowing with milk and honey.

10: Now, behold, I have brought the first of the fruit of the ground,

which You, the LORD, have given me. You shall set it down before the LORD your God,

which the LORD your God has given to you, and to your house, you, and the Levite,

and the sojourner who is in the midst of you. 12: When you have concluded tithing all the tithe of your increase in the third year, which is the year of tithing,

then you shall give it to the Levite, to the sojourner, to the fatherless, and to the widow,

that they may eat within your gates, and be satisfied. 13: You shall say before the LORD your God,

I have put away the holy thing out of my house, and also have given it to the Levite, and to the sojourner, to the fatherless, and to the widow, according to all Your commandments which You have commanded me:

I have not transgressed any of Your commandments, neither have I forgotten them: 14:

I have not eaten of it in my mourning, neither have I put away of it while unclean, nor given of it for the dead:

I have listened to the voice of the LORD my God; I have done according to all that You have commanded me.

15: Look down from Your holy habitation, from heaven,

and bless Your people Yisrael, and the land which You have given us,

as You swore to our fathers, a land flowing with milk and honey.
