
Todd's work in the Jewish Community began in 2008 at Chicago Jewish Day







# **AES Community Announcements**



For several years, Rabbi Siegel recognized a growing need in the community for Jewish gravesites within the city. In response, Anshe Emet, through its Endowment Fund, purchased 40 plots at Rosehill Cemetery in 2018. Those plots sold very quickly and with just a few remaining, the Endowment Fund has now purchased a number of additional plots available to congregants to purchase.

Founded in 1859, Rosehill Cemetery is the largest—and one of the older cemeteries in the city of Chicago. Located in the North Ravenswood neighborhood, the park comprises 350 acres of beautifully manicured grounds that encompasses peaceful lakes, green gardens and decades of history. An architectural wonder, the Rosehill Cemetery Gatehouse dates back to 1864 and was designed by famed architect William Boyington, who also designed the Chicago Water Tower, one of the city's most recognizable historical landmarks. Unfortunately, many of the buildings designed by Boyington were destroyed in the Great Chicago Fire of 1871 and the Gatehouse is one of the few Boyington pre-fire buildings that remain. Tours of the property are available and we encourage you to visit.
