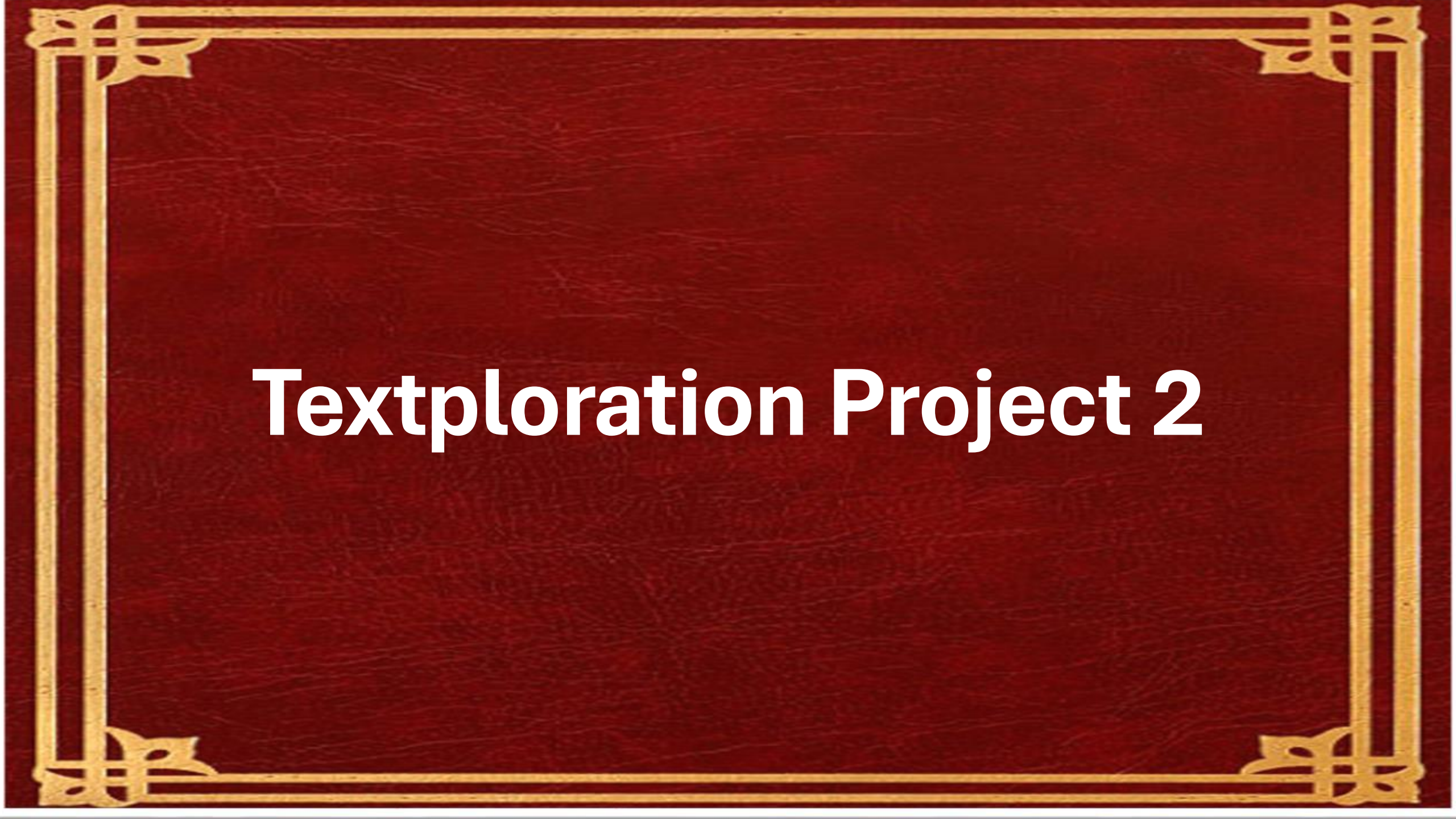


For Teachers
